Suven to present at 11TH CLINICAL TRIALS ON ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE (CTAD) during OCTOBER 24-27, 2018 - BARCELONA, SPAIN

HYDERABAD, INDIA (Oct 23, 2018) – Suven Life Sciences is participating and presenting the baseline patient demographics and scales from the ongoing phase-2a proof-of-concept trial of SUVN-502 for moderate Alzheimer's Disease at 11TH CLINICAL TRIALS ON ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE (CTAD) during OCTOBER 24-27, 2018 at BARCELONA, SPAIN

SUVN-502 is a promising pure, 5-HT6 receptor antagonist in development for the treatment of moderate Alzheimer's Disease, a novel triple combination treatment approach.

This trial evaluates the efficacy and safety of SUVN-502 added to background stable donepezil and memantine, a triple therapy in subjects with moderate AD dementia.

At CTAD, Suven is presenting the baseline patient demographics and scales from the ongoing phase-2a proof-of-concept trial of SUVN-502 for moderate Alzheimer's Disease.

Top-line efficacy results from this study are expected during August/September of 2019
